<b>1. Michel Servin Blanc</b> <b>France (I)</b> Light and straightforward, with an up-front nose of citrus fruits, tinged with a subtle leafy character. Crisp and dry on the palate, with plenty of refreshing acidic bite.	£16.75	£4.50	£5.75
<b>2. Chemin Des Dames Colombard</b> <b>South of France (3)</b> A medium dry wine, offering a fresh aromatic bouquet followed by honeydew melon fruit and an attractive sweetness, with good balancing acidity.	£16.75	£4.50	£5.75
<b>3. Alfredini Garganega Pinot Grigio</b> <b>Italy (I)</b> Light in colour, refreshing, and crisp and with aromas of limes, grapefruits and lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.	£17.50	£5.00	£6.25
<b>4. Five Foot Track Chardonnay</b> <b>Australia (2)</b> Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel.	£17.50	£5.00	£6.25
<b>5. Picpoul Plo d'Isabelle, Picpoul de Pinet</b> <b>France (I)</b> Youthfully pale lemon yellow, with a nose of lemon and lime fruit, and an intriguing blend of white blossom and green herb notes. Vibrant green apple fruit with a refreshingly dry and acidic finish.	£20.00		
<b>6. Camino Real Blanco Rioja</b> <b>Spain (I)</b> An interesting and complex wine. Ripe fruit flavours with notes of date and banana results in a mouth filling finish and pleasant aftertaste.	£20.00		
<b>7. Fathom's Sauvignon Blanc</b> <b>New Zealand (I)</b> Typical of Marlborough Sauvignon, the bouquet springs from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. The palate is a burst of crisp grapefruit and gooseberry flavours.	£22.50	£6.00	£7.50
<b>8. Penfolds Autumn Riesling</b> <b>Australia (I)</b> An ever-evolving sensorial experience – Is it sweet, or is it dry? Sweet poached pear and lemon curd are balanced by Granny Smith apple purity. Touches of Petrol on the nose with a weighty rounded pallet, an excellent example of Riesling.	£25.00		
<b>9. Pouilly-Fumé Jean Vincent</b> <b>Loire, France (I)</b> An intensely aromatic wine, with a nose that centres on gooseberry fruit, enhanced by a smoky, flinty character. This mineral theme continues all the way to the long, steely finish.	£25.00		
<b>10. Chablis 'La Maladière', William Fèvre</b> <b>Burgundy, France (I)</b> With a searing backbone of acidity and bone-dry finish balanced by fresh lime, lemon and orange fruits, this wine also displays nuances of flint and chalk on the nose.	£30.00

<b>11. Tavino Sangiovese</b> <b>Italy (B)</b> Aromas of cherry, raspberry and plum follow onto the palate with juicy tannins giving a lovely smooth texture.	£16.75	£4.50	£5.75
<b>12. McGuigan Merlot</b> <b>Australia (C)</b> A soft and flavoursome wine with ripe red fruits including raspberry, cherry and plum. This is accompanied by subtle hints of oak.	£17.50	£5.00	£6.25
<b>13. Five Foot Track Shiraz</b> <b>Australia (C)</b> A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.	£20.00	£5.50	£7.00
<b>14. Sant'Andrea Chianti</b> <b>Italy (D)</b> A lively ruby colour, this is a classic Chianti offering a nose of cherry-like fruit and subtle floral hints and a dry, harmonious palate combining lip-smacking acidity and fine tannins.	£20.00		
<b>15. Capilla De Barro Malbec</b> <b>Argentina (D)</b> An intense red-purple colour, with an equally intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins.	£22.50		
<b>16. Rioja Reserva, Vina Eguia</b> <b>Spain (C)</b> Beautifully deep ruby coloured, with subtle cedar hints to the rim. The bouquet is an intense mix of dark fruit, toasted oak and clove aromas. The palate has weight yet an elegant profile.	£22.50		
<b>17. Esprit de Lussac, Lussac St-Emilion</b> <b>Bordeaux, France (C)</b> This is a rich, full bodied wine showing great concentration of flavour. With juicy black fruit on the nose and palate backed up by a smoky sandalwood character.	£25.00		
<b>18. Jim Barry Cover Drive, Cabernet Sauvignon</b> <b>Australia (C)</b> This wine has been named in commemoration of the Penola cricket ground, which used to lie on the very site where Jim Barry now grows this premium Cabernet, which is blended with small parcels from the family's Clare Valley estate, then aged in French and American oak. The nose is very fragrant, dominated by intense cassis and cedar, with nuances of fennel and damson. A generous palate with succulent tannins framing blackcurrant, liquorice and cherry flavours.	£25.00	£6.50	£8.75
<b>19. Fairhall Cliffs Pinot Noir</b> <b>New Zealand (B)</b> Hand-picked and aged for 9 months in French oak, this is a classic, rounded Marlborough Pinot Noir. With a subtle smoky character and rounded red berry fruit aromas, on the palate this wine is warming and rich, encompassing every corner of the mouth and leaving a long and smooth finish.	£27.50		
<b>20. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Puits Neuf</b> <b>Rhône, France (C)</b> A powerful, savoury-sweet bouquet of ripe black fruit and peppery spice, along with pungent herb notes redolent of thyme and rosemary. Fine tannins and hints of liquorice provide great length.	£30.00
