Welcome

The White Lodge Hotel is a small, charming hotel situated at the end of Filey's historic Victorian Crescent with expansive views overlooking Filey Bay.

The hotel has twenty-one en-suite rooms; a restaurant, bar and lounge bar as well as a large outside terrace, and a room for private parties and special events.

At a Glance

3 Level Access

- The main entrance has five steps and a handrail. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - Dining Table
 - Garden Terrace

Travel by public transport

- You can get to White Lodge Hotel by bus and train.
- The nearest bus stop is at the Filey bus station on Station Avenue near the railway station and Tesco supermarket. The bus stop is 0.5 miles / 0.8 km from White Lodge Hotel.

- The nearest train station is Filey railway station. The train station is 0.5 miles / 0.8 km from White Lodge Hotel.
- The journey from the train and bus station is a ten minute walk. The terrain is flat and paved, without any hills or inclines to consider

Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Lazer Taxis by calling 01723 515515. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.
- You can get a taxi with Nippy Taxis by calling 01723 377377. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

Parking

- We have a car park. There are accessible parking spaces. Parking is not free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- From the parking to the main entrance, there are five steps. There is no ramp and no lift.
- There is a ramp for access to the hotel located at the side entrance which takes you through the restaurant and lounge to Reception









Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 1200mm wide, or more.

Main entrance

- The door is 950mm wide.
- The main entrance has five steps.
- This entrance has a handrail.
- The main door is side hung and manual.
- The other entrance door is 770.00mm wide.
- The ramp is located on the side of the hotel easily accessed from the front of the hotel. There is a sharp turn on the ramp which leads up with access directly in to the restaurant then in to the Lounge and then Reception
- Please notify Reception when accessing via the ramp as the door may be locked.

Visual Impairment - General Information

• Some parts of the venue have low lighting.



- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, bedside lamps, desk or table lamps and natural daylight.

- Lights are LED and energy saving. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.

Restaurant

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access. There is a permanent ramp. The route is 1000mm wide, or more. The door is 770mm wide.
- To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music.
- We cater for vegetarian, gluten free (celiacs), lactose free (dairy free), nut free and vegan specific diets.

Getting around outside

Garden Terrace

• From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 1200mm wide, or more. The entrance is 770mm wide.

Accessibility equipment

- We provide wheelchairs. Wheelchairs are free.
- Toilet seat risers
- Toilet seat frames
- Many bathrooms have hand rails in bathtubs, showers and toilets
- Mobility Scooters can be hired daily and weekly from a local mobility specialist (Dixon's of Filey, 01723 512001).
- The nearest toilet for assistance dogs is in the park next to the hotel.
- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- We can charge the mobility scooters in our garage
- You can hire mobility equipment (Dixon's 01723 512001).
